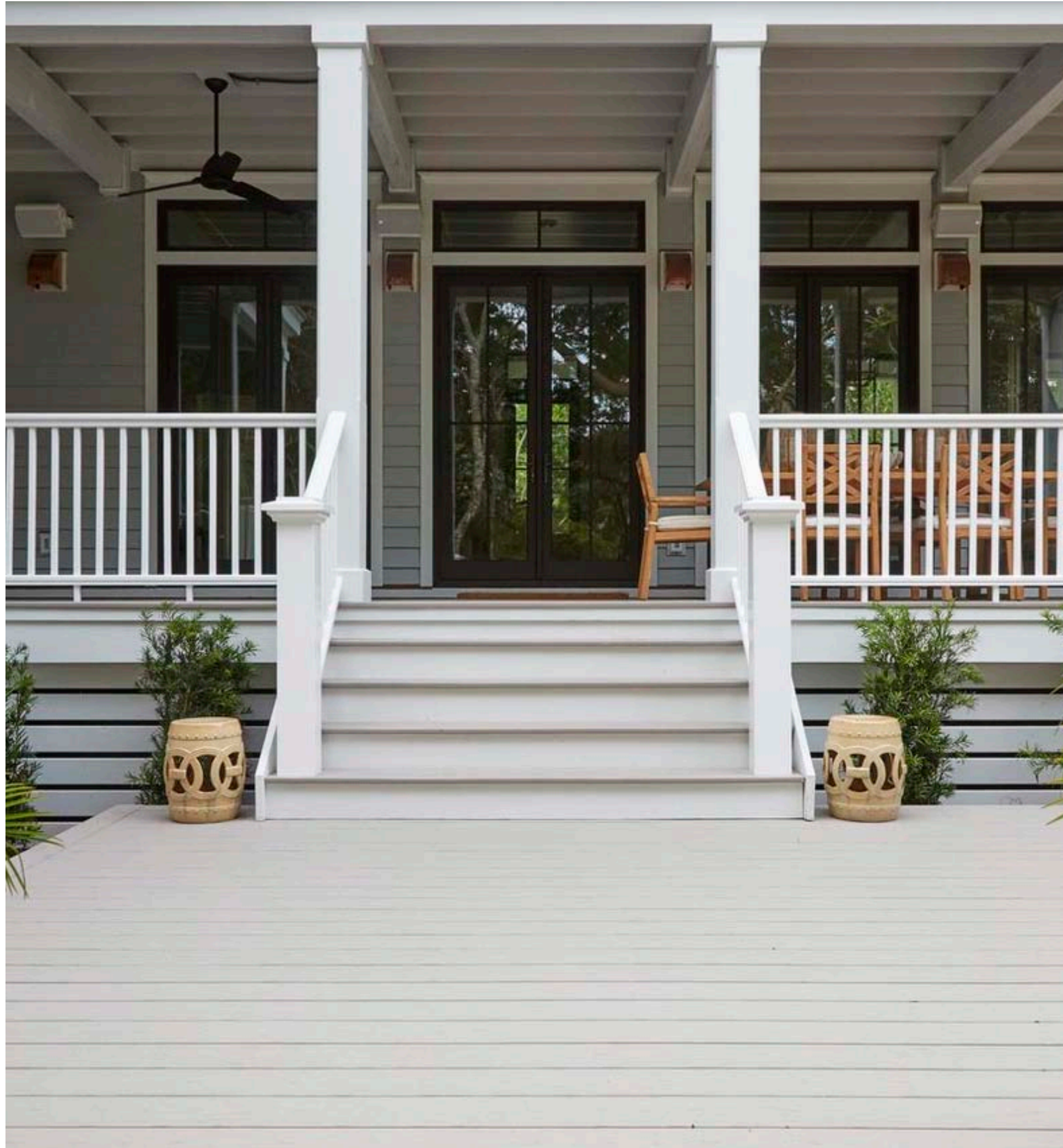

## THE DECK BUILDING PROCESS

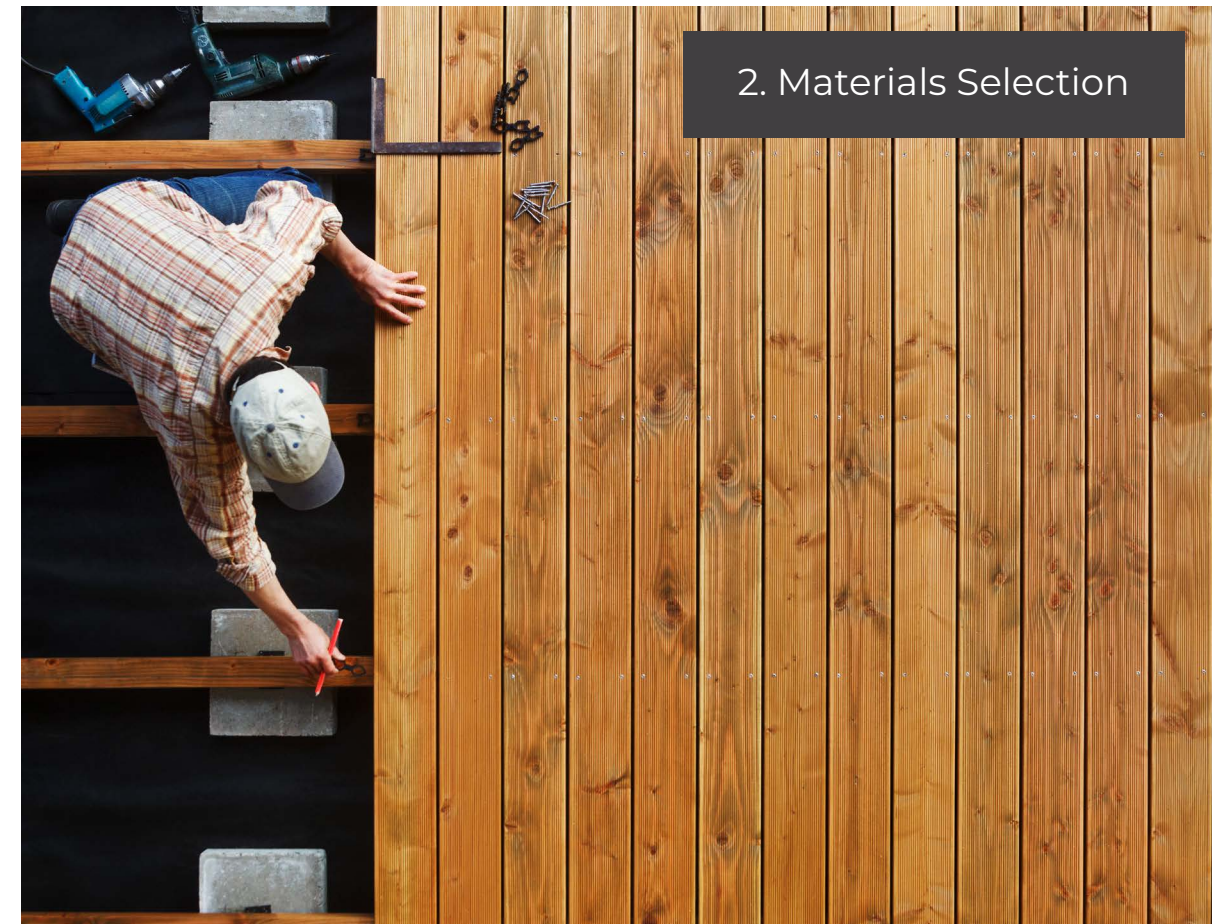
We only take on one project at a time to ensure your dream deck gets the attention it deserves. Our decks are always built to meet or exceed local and regional codes and regulations.

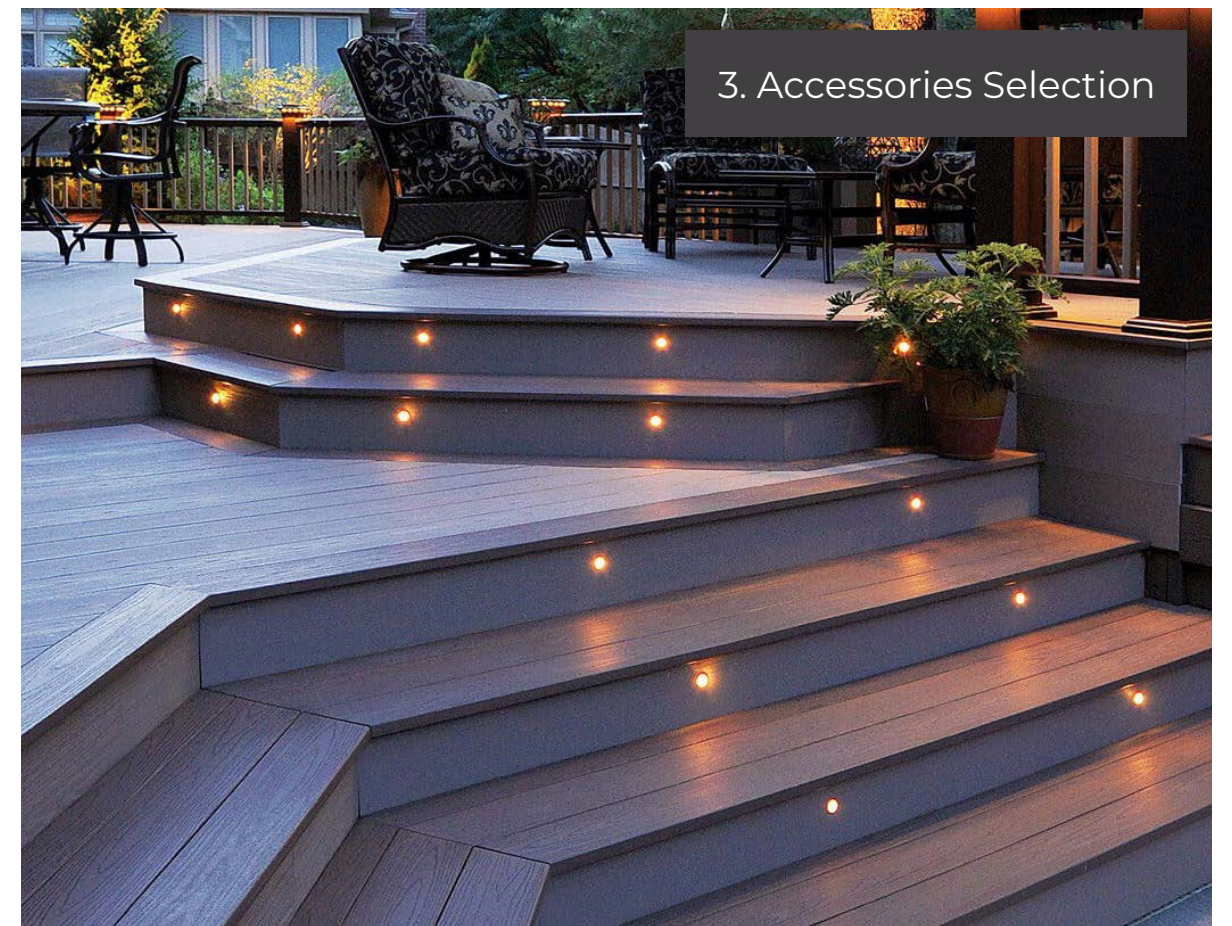

# FOOTING OPTIONS

## Footing and Foundation Options

Our standard foundation choice for most projects consists of poured concrete footings. Concrete footings are dug and poured directly into the ground. Installation is weather permitting, and the concrete requires curing time before deck building can move forward. Concrete footings are also very strong and provide plenty of support for your deck.

Helical pile foundations can be installed any time of year, even when the ground is frozen! These modern alternatives can be installed in rocky and uneven terrain, where traditional footing installation is not possible. Constructed from galvanized steel, they will last a lifetime.

Wood substructures split, warp and shift over time, leading to an uneven surface in the deck boards above. The dimensionally stable steel of Trex Elevations stays in place, giving you consistently flat decking.







## Trex® RainEscape®

Create a dry space below your deck

- Uses a network of troughs and gutters to divert water from the deck
- Shields the area below the deck from rain, snow, sun, and other elements
- Provides 100% protection of the deck substructure from moisture
- Holds screws in place longer
- Backed by a 20-year warranty

## Above the Joist System

- Trex RainEscape is an above-the joist deck drainage system.
- Systems installed above the joist provide 100% protection of the deck substructure from moisture penetration.
- By comparison, an under-the-joist system allows water to run through the decking boards, over the joists and into the drainage system below.
- When the joists get repeatedly wet, they will eventually rot.

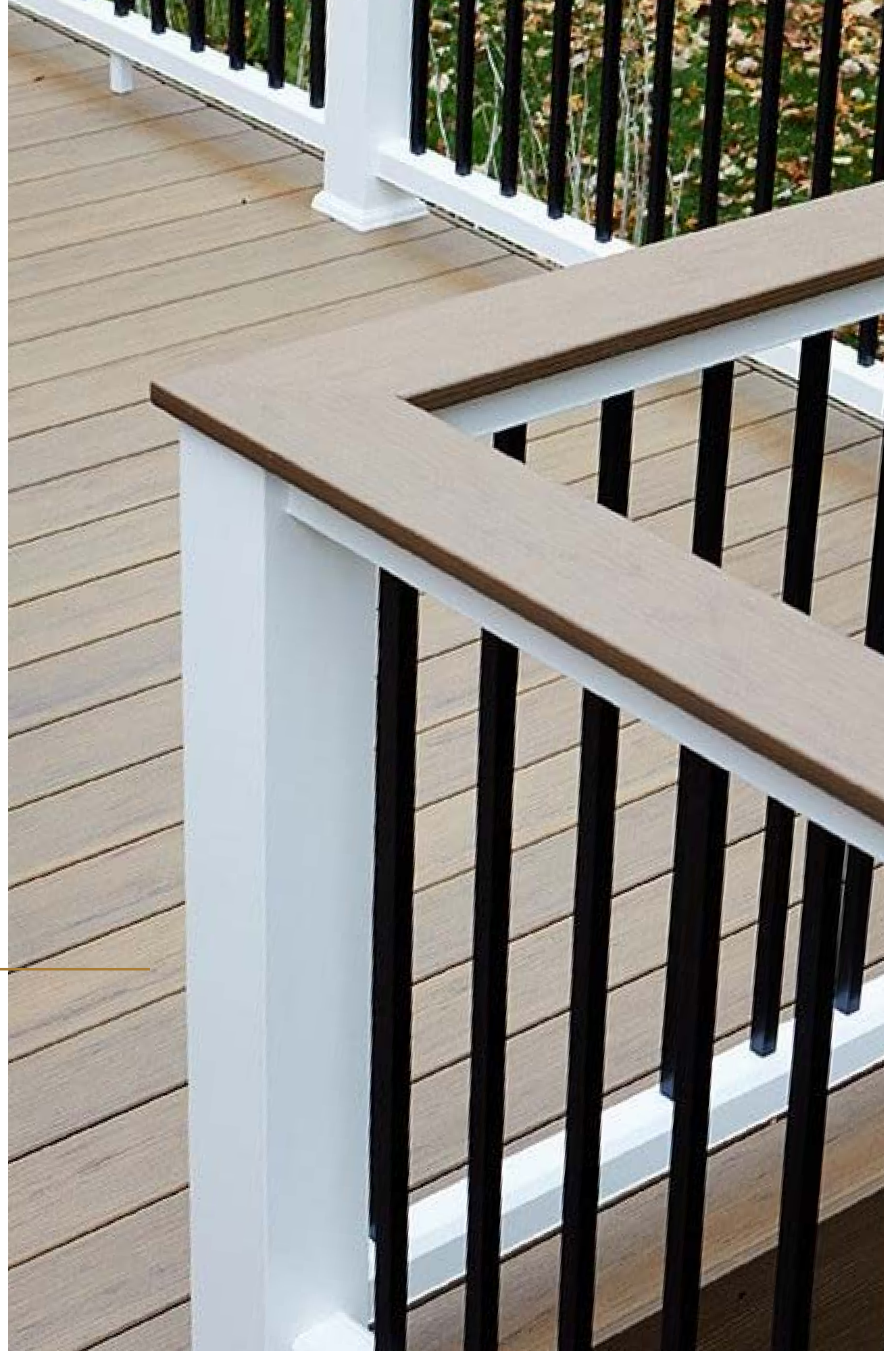

Skirting and trim help tie the visual appearance of the deck together by hiding the structural workings underneath. The sky is the limit when it comes to material and style options.







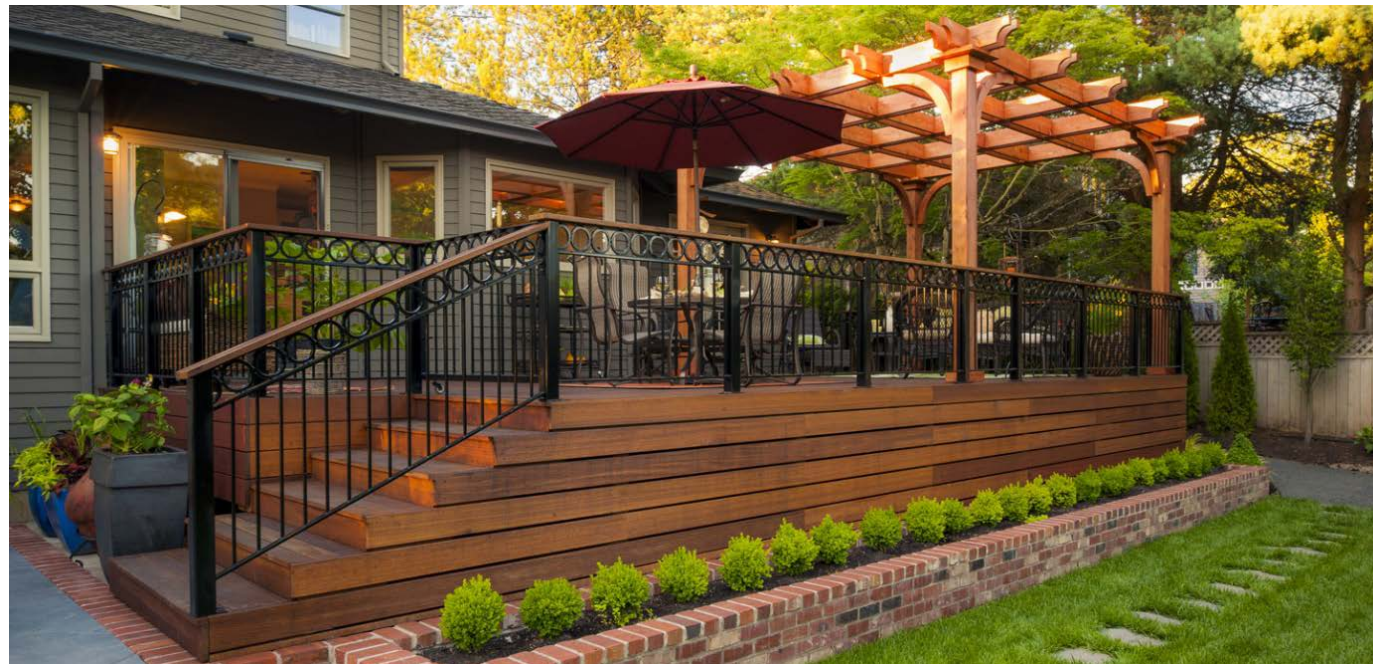
### Horizontal Fascia Boards

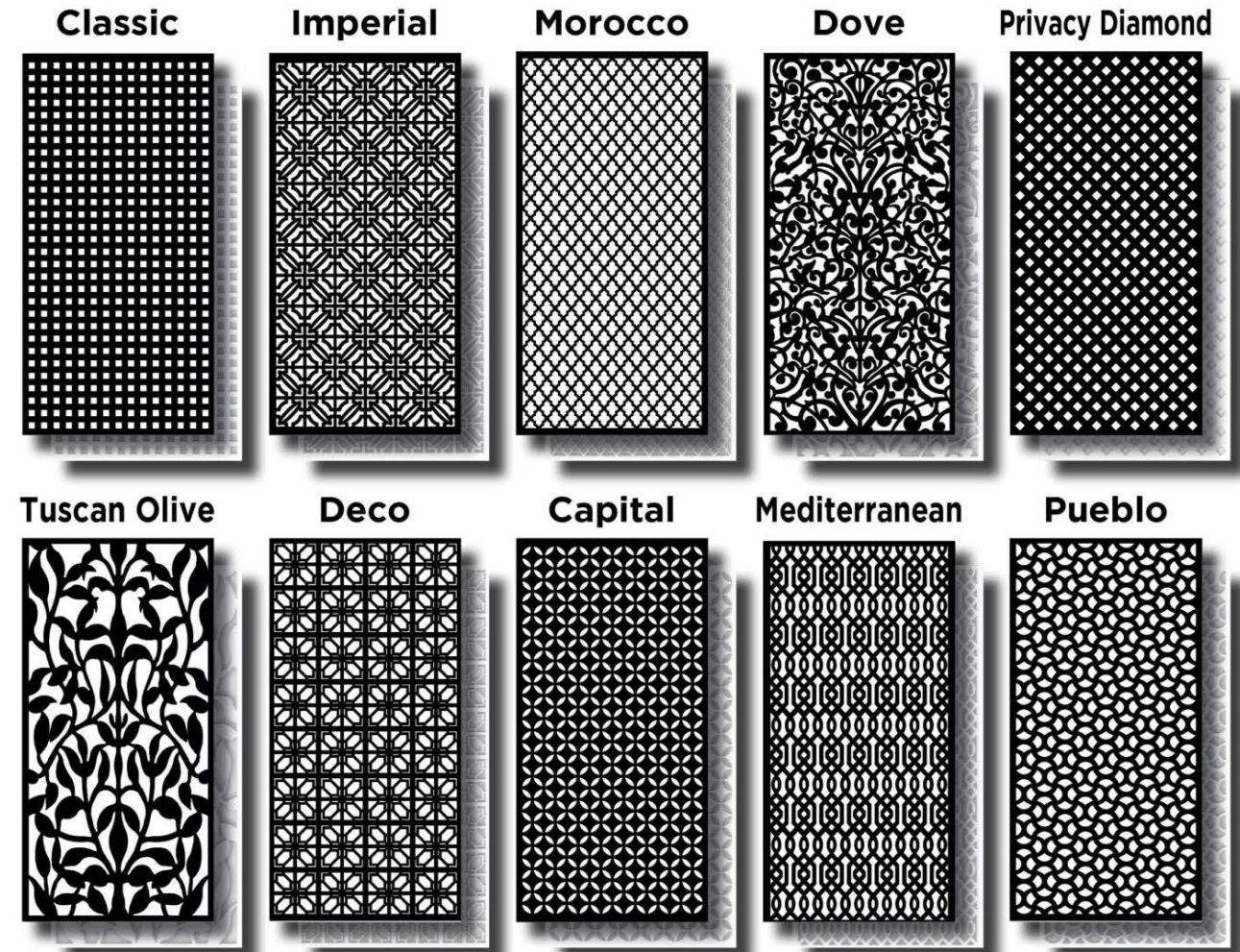

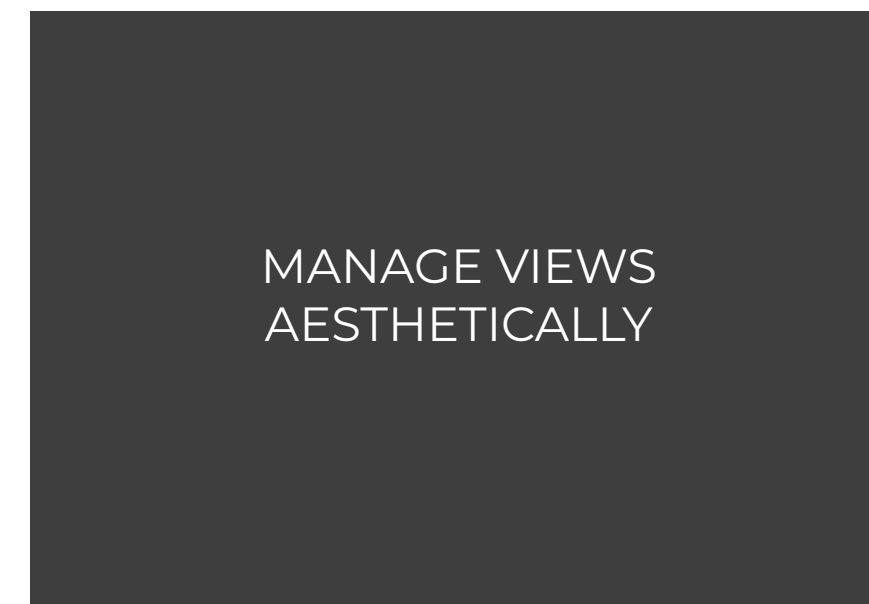

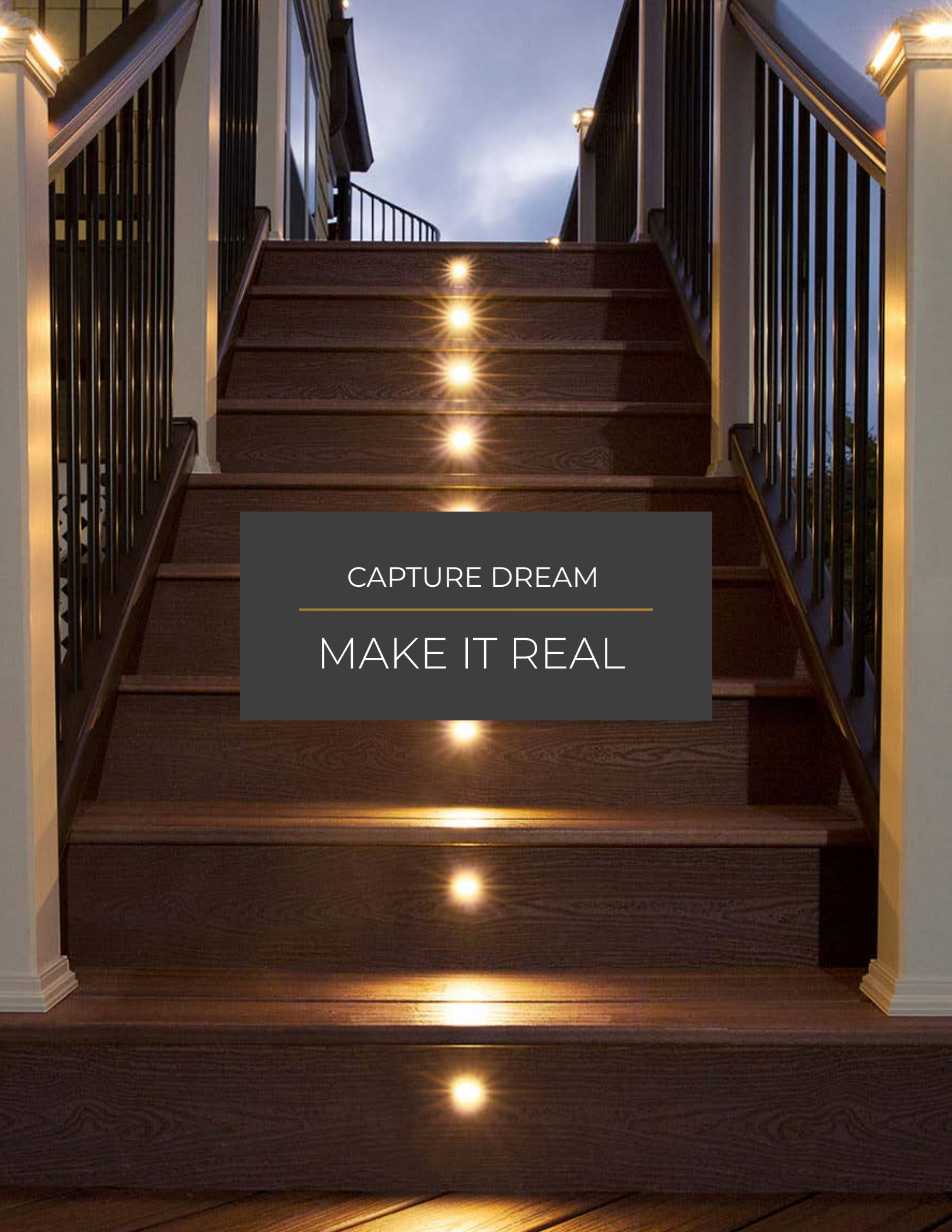
